Jagannathpore, 24 Pgs (N), West Bengal, represented by Dr. Saptarshi Chatterjee, Chief Coordinator & Principal Project Investigator, E-YUVA Centre, who has been duly authorized in this behalf which expression shall where the context so admits, be deemed to include its successors, executors and administrators, assigns and nominees (herein after referred to as "E-YUVA Centre, Adamas University" which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, includes its successor in office, legal representatives and permitted assigns) of the SECOND PARTY

WHEREAS, E-YUVA Centre, Adamas University and Kanchrapara College would be involved in creating an innovation and entrepreneurship ecosystem, aimed towards a self-reliant nation.

WHEREAS, E-YUVA Centre and Kanchrapara College would take initiatives and handhold in all possible ways, mutually decided by both the parties to meet the objective under this MoU

Now it is hereby mutually agreed amongst both parties to this MoU and binds themselves to the terms and conditions enumerated in succeeding paragraphs/Annexures:

1. Roles and Responsibility

3. Financial Terms and Conditions

The financial terms and conditions will be at set out in Annexure B.

4. Duration/Term of the MOU

- A. The MOU shall begin from the date of its execution by the parties hereto.
- B. This MOU shall continue in full force and effect up to 3 years from the date of signing i.e. upto 28.04.2025.
- C. On or before expire of this understanding, the MoU shall be extended for further such period/ batches as the parties may deem fit and proper or as overall agreed upon by the parties to the MoU.
- D. This Memorandam of Understanding is a document of good faith and Implementation of the MOU would be monitored on a six-recently basis.

5. Termination

- a) Either party may terminate this MOU by mutual understanding by giving 3 (three) months' notice in writing served on other.
- b) The parties to the MOU understand that, where a joint program entitative, is under continuance, the termination shall take effect only on completion of the substisting program/initiative.
- c) Save as otherwise set out in this MOU, the sermination of this MOU howsoever arising is without prejudice to the rights, duties and liabilities of either party accrued prior to termination.

Confidentiality

- a) Each party hereta agrees with the other:
 - · To keep information in strict confidence and secrecy.
 - Not to use the information save for complying with its obligations under this MOU.
 - Not to disclose the same to a third party other than the party's professional advisers and such employees of the other party on a need to know basis as per requirements of this MOU, who are under a similar duty to protect confidential information, or any third party having a legal right to obtain disclosure thereof.
- b) The restrictions contained in above clause shall apply to both the parties during the term of and for (one) year after the termination of this MOU but shall cease to apply to information or knowledge which:
 - · Has in it's entirely become public knowledge otherwise than through any unauthorised disclosure or other breach of such restriction

The other party has consented in writing to the same being disclosed.

 Is or has been independently developed by the other party without reference to or use of the confidential information.

8. Dispute Resolution

Any disputes and differences whatsoever arising under or in connection with this MOU which could not be settled by parties through negotiations, after the period of thirty (30) working days from the service of the notice, shall be finally settled by arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The parties will make reference for a sole arbitratur to be appointed by the parties in consultation with each other. The place of arbitration shall be at Kolkata.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) has come into effect fromtoday i.e, 09/07/2021 (date of effect) to establish an agreement betweenHAZI A.K. KHAN COLLEGE, a West Bengal Government Aided Undergraduate Degree College with its office at Hariharpara PS- Hariharpara, Dist - Murshidabad, WB, Pin-742166, established in 2008 affiliated to University of Kalyani, hereinafter referred to as HAZI A. K. KHAN COLLEGE and represented by its Principal, referred to as FIRST PARTY, for the purpose of exchange of students, staff and faculties.

AND

Kanchrapara College, a West Bengal Government Aided Undergraduate Degree College with its office at Kanchrapara, Dist. North 24 Parganas, WB, India, Pin-743145, established in 1972, hereinafter referred to as KANCHRAPARACOLLEGE and represented by its Principal, referred to as SECOND PARTY.

The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually/ collectively as college/colleges.

PREAMBLE

Whereas, HAZI A. K. KHAN COLLEGE and KANCHRAPARA COLLEGE have many areas of common interest in the Faculty of Arts, so considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit for academic excellence on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, pedagogy and research.

Now therefore, HAZI A. K. KHAN COLLEGE and KANCHRAPARA COLLEGE have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU), which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two institutions in the following sections.

ARTICLE 1: OBJECTIVE

To develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on the basis of equality and reciprocity, the two institutions shall seek to promote:

A.Faculty/Staff exchanges

A.Faculty/Staff exchanges

Both the institutions will promote:

- Exchange of faculty for the common UG Major, Honours & Programmes Courses for mutual benefit of both the institutions.
- Collaboration in teaching, research and development, and consultancy studies in the field of mutual iii
- Exchange of academic materials and publications. iii.
- Exchange of lectures by teachers with the opportunity to teach or conduct research.
- Joint research activities wherever feasible. ٧.
- Participating in seminars, workshops, symposia, other kinds of academic discussions. vi.
- Conduction of study tours and joint consultancy work wherever feasible. vii.

A specific plan will be worked out for each activity and detailed arrangements for such collaborative work will be agreed upon

B. Student Exchange

- a) Students exchange programme will be conducted on mutual understanding between two colleges.
- b) Exchanged students may be evaluated by the host institution if such an evaluative framework for the academic interest of students be worked out. This will in no way impede or influence her/his evaluation in own college or university assessment/ evaluation.

- To exchange information and experiences on research and educational programmes.
- b) To exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes.
- e) To organize seminars, faculty development programmes, workshops jointly on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein.
- d) To explore the provision of cultural and intellectual enrichment opportunities for staff, faculty and students of both the institutes.
- e) To use library reading room facilities for a specified period.
- f) To use Computer laboratory and L.C.T. facilities in specific cases (with prior approval of Head of the Institutions) for a limited period.
- g) Exchange of N.T.S. for mutual interest of college administration, exchange of experience and skill (viz. office management, student database management, financial management & other I.T. uses etc.)

HAZI A K KHAN COLLEGE and KANCHRAPARA COLLEGEhaveagreed that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be determined separately and havealso agreed upon by the two colleges. These terms will include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements and person(s) responsible for its implementation.

ARTICLE 2: COORDINATION

Each college shall appoint one member of its teaching faculty to coordinate & fast track the programme on behalf of the Head of the Institution of each college. Further, a Coordination Committee consisting of two Heads of the Institution and the two Coordinators will periodically (once a year) reviews and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between two colleges.

ARTICLE 3: CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

The two colleges will retain and respect individual confidentiality, including those pertaining to the collaborative activities of both the colleges.

ARTICLE 4: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Ownership of any intellectual property (including confidential information, know-how, patents, copyrights, design rights, rights relating to computer software and any other industrial or intellectual property rights) developed jointly during the course of this MoU shall be vested on both the colleges in this MoU. Both the colleges shall have right to determine the commercial implications, disposition and exploitation of such intellectual property and shall make joint applications for the registration of the same. Any publication regarding such intellectual property shall only be possible with prior written consent of both the colleges.

ARTICLES 5: VALIDITY

Initially, the MoU shall remain in force for a period of five (05) years commencing from the date of effect, the Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both the authorities after review.

ARTICLE 6: TERMINATION

Termination of this MOU is subject to prior notification of 1(one) month from any of these Institutions.

ARTICLE 7: LEGAL EFFECT

Nothing in this MoU shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the two colleges. This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

ARTICLE 8: DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In case of a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, Head of the Institutions of both the colleges will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect and shared responsibility.

HAZI A K KHAN COLLEGE and KANCHRAPARA COLLEGE welcome the signing of this Memorandum of cooperation and jointly agree to the provisions set out as above.
