Educational Qualification :

(a) Science Subjects

Candidates should have passed Intermediate/10+2/ Equivalent examination with Mathematics, Physics and English from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English.

OR

Passed Three years Diploma Course in Engineering (Mechanical / Electrical / Electronics / Automobile / Computer Science / Instrumentation Technology / Information Technology) from Central, State and UT recognized Polytechnic institute with 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English in Diploma Course (or in Intermediate/Matriculation, if English is not a subject in Diploma Course).

OR

Passed Two years Vocational Course with non-vocational subject viz. Physics and Mathematics from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English in Vocational Course (or in Intermediate / Matriculation, if English is not a subject in Vocational Course).

(b) Other than Science Subjects

Passed Intermediate / 10+2 / Equivalent Examination in any stream/subjects from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English.

OR

Passed two years Vocational Course from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English in Vocational Course (or in Intermediate / Matriculation if English is not a subject in Vocational Course).

**Note - 1:** Candidates eligible for Science Subjects examination (Including Intermediate/ 10+2/three years diploma course in engineering or two years vocational course with non-vocational subjects of Physics and Maths) are also eligible for Other than Science Subjects and would be given an option of appearing in both Science Subjects and Other than Science Subjects examination in one sitting while filling up the online registration form.

1. Pursuant to the New HR methodology for induction of Agniveeswari under Agnipath Scheme, aimed to provide an opportunity to Nation's youth to experience military way of life for a period of four years, Indian Air Force invites Online applications from unmarried Indian male and female candidates for selection test from 17 March 2024 onwards to join the IAF as an AGNIYEEVAYU. The number and employability of female candidates will be decided as per service requirement.

(THE SELECTION TEST IS NOT FOR SELECTION AS COMMISSIONED OFFICER/RB/PILOTS/NAVIGATORS/AIR MEN)

2. Application is required to be filed only ONLINE by the candidates and detailed instructions to fill up the same are available at [www.cass.gov.in](http://www.cass.gov.in)

3. The examination is valid for AGNIYEEVAYU INTAKE 01/2025

4. ONLINE REGISTRATION shall commence at 1100h on 17 January 2024 and will close at 2300h on 06 February 2024. Only ONLINE REGISTERED applications shall be accepted. For registration log on to [www.cass.gov.in](http://www.cass.gov.in)

5. Candidates are advised to register at the earliest opportunity as no extension of registration dates will be accommodated.

## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

### 5. Age:

(a) Date of Birth Block: Candidate born between 02 January 2004 and 02 July 2007 (both dates inclusive) are eligible to apply.

(b) In case a candidate clears at the stages of the Selection Procedure, then the upper age limit as on date of enrolment should be 21 years.

6. **Marital Status and Pregnancy:** Only unmarried candidates (male & female) will be eligible for enrolment as Agniveeswari and they shall undertake not to marry during the defined engagement period of four years. Keeping in view limited period of engagement of Agniveeswari inclusive of training, skill development activities, political as well as formative assessment and organisational requirement of continued service of Agniveeswari during the specified period, longer tenure of Agniveeswari during the engagement period will adversely affect the operational efficiency of the Indian Air Force. Agniveeswari who marry during the said period shall be discharged from the service. Further, only unmarried Agniveeswari will be eligible for selection in Regular cadre as Airman. Female candidates additionally shall be required to undertake not to get pregnant during the engagement period of four years. Such women Agniveeswari becoming Low Medical Category (LMC) due to pregnancy shall be liable to be discharged from service. Pregnancy will disbar the women Agniveeswari's selection into Regular Cadre. At the time of enrolment, candidates shall require to sign a voluntary undertaking accepting above conditions.

### 7. Educational Qualification

#### (a) Science Subjects

Candidates should have passed Intermediate/10+2/ Equivalent examination with Mathematics, Physics and English from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English.

OR

Passed Three years Diploma Course in Engineering (Mechanical / Electrical / Electronics / Automobile / Computer Science / Instrumentation Technology / Information Technology) from Central, State and UT recognized Polytechnic Institute with 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English in Diploma Course (or in Intermediate/Mathematics, if English is not a subject in Diploma Course).

OR

Passed Two years Vocational Course with non-vocational subject viz. Physics and Mathematics from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English in Vocational Course (or in Intermediate / Mathematics, if English is not a subject in Vocational Course).

#### (b) Other than Science Subjects

Passed Intermediate / 10+2 / Equivalent Examination in any streams/subjects from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English.

OR

Passed two years Vocational Course from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English in Vocational Course (or in Intermediate / Mathematics if English is not a subject in Vocational Course).

Note - 1: Candidates eligible for Science Subjects examination (including Intermediate/10+2三年课程) in engineering or two years' vocational course with non-vocational subjects of Physics and Maths) are also eligible for Other than Science Subjects and would be given an option of appearing in both Science Subjects and Other than Science Subjects examination in one sitting while filling up the online registration form.

Note - 2: Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT as on date of registrations shall only be considered.

Note - 3: Exam Aggregate Percentage of marks before decimal as written in the marks sheet of 10+2/Intermediate/Equivalent Examination/Three Years Diploma Course/Two years' Vocational Course OR calculated as per the rules of concerned Education Board / Polytechnic Institute shall only be considered (For example 49.99% should be taken as 49% and not to be rounded off to 50%).

### 8. Mandatory Medical Standards: General Medical Standards for AGNIYEEVAYU male & female candidates are as follows:-

#### (a) Height:

(i) For Male candidates, Minimum acceptable height is 152.5 cms.

(ii) For Female candidates, Minimum acceptable height is 152 cms. For candidates belonging to North East or hilly regions of Uttrakhand, a lower minimum height of 147 cms will be accepted. In case of candidates from Lakshadweep, the minimum height will be 150 cms.

Note : Candidates availing height relaxation for being domicile of North East/Hilly Regions of Uttrakhand/Lakshadweep are to submit domicile certificate with endorsement of domicile status at the time of Phase-II testing. Further, candidates from hilly regions of Uttrakhand must have specific endorsement of hilly region in their domicile certificate.

#### (b) Weight: Proportionate to height

#### (c) Chest:

(i) For Male Candidates \* The chest wall should be well proportioned and well developed. Minimum chest circumference should be 77 cms and the chest expansion should be atleast 05 cms.

(ii) For Female candidates, The chest wall should be well proportioned and well developed with the minimum range of expansion of 05 cms.

#### (d) Hearing: Candidate should have normal hearing i.e. able to hear forced whisper from a distance of 6 meters by each ear separately.

#### (e) Dental: Should have healthy & sound set of teeth and maximum 14 dental points.

#### (f) Visual standards :

#### (g) Corneal Surgery (PRK/LASIK) is not acceptable.

Note: Candidates should bring prescription and spectacles for corrected vision, if being used. The latest prescription should contain proper measurement, both right & left eye, your name, stamp, signature and date of prescription should be within a month prior to appearing for medical examination.

(h) General Health: Candidates should be physically fit without loss of any appendages. He / She should be free from any active or latent acute or chronic medical or physical disorder like tuberculosis, disease, infection and skin ailments. Candidate shall be physically and mentally fit to perform duty in any part of the world, Army, Airforce and Territorial.

(i) Gynaecological Examination (If female candidate): The examination covers external genitalia, uterine orifice and the perineum, any evidence of strong urinary incontinence of gynaecological nature.

(k) Gender (For female candidates): Any candidate found to have predominant characteristics of the opposite gender as per our general physical examination, will be rejected as unfit. Any candidate having undergone gender reassignment surgery will be declared unfit.

(l) Pregnancy (For female candidates): Any candidate, if found pregnant shall be disqualified and her candidature will be rejected.

(m) Details of medical standards are available on CASS web portal [www.cass.gov.in](http://www.cass.gov.in)

9. Consumption of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS): Consumption of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic substances banned under the NDPS Act 1961 shall be a reject criteria for selection into the IAF. AGNIYEEVAYU found either in possession or storing or distributing or consuming such drugs and substances after enrolment shall be liable for disciplinary action including dismissal from the IAF. ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY TO ALCOHOLISM AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE IS FOLLOWED IN IAF.

10. Body Tattoos: Permanent body tattoos are not permitted, however, tattoos only on inner face of the fore arm (inside of the wrist), back (dorsal) part of the hand/wrist side of the arm and fingers which are per the custom and tradition of their states may be considered. Offensive obscene, indecent, sexist or racial tattoos are prohibited regardless of location on the body. However, right to consider a tattoo acceptable or unacceptable will rest with the selection centre. Candidates with permanent body tattoos are to submit two Postcard size photographs (close up and distant view) with details of size and type of the tattoo during the second phase of testing.

11. Only Sikh candidates whose religion prohibits cutting of hair or shaving of face shall be permitted to grow their natural beard and moustache. Accordingly, those Sikhs candidates willing to let go the same as per laid down specification are to get their photographs with beard and moustache.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

12. Agniveeswari will be enrolled in the Indian Air Force under Air Force Act 1950, for a period of FOUR years. Agniveeswari would form a distinct rank in the Indian Air Force, different from any other existing ranks. The Indian Air Force is not obliged to retain Agniveeswari beyond the engagement period of four years.

13. On completion of four years of service, based on organisation's requirements and policies promulgated by the Indian Air Force, Agniveeswari will be offered an opportunity to apply for enrolment in the regular cadre of the Indian Air Force as Airman. These applications will be considered in a centralized manner based on objective criteria, including performance during their four year engagement period and up to 25% of each specific batch of Agniveeswari will be admitted in regular cadre of IAF. Agniveeswari will not have any right to be selected for further enrolment into the Indian Air Force. Selection of the Agniveeswari for further enrolment, if any, shall be at the discretion of the Government of India.

14. Employability: Agniveeswari enrolled under this entry are liable to be assigned any duty in organisational interest at the discretion of the Indian Air Force.

15. Training: On being enroled, Agniveeswari will be imparted military training based on Indian Air Force requirements.

16. Leave: Grant of leave will be subject to exigencies of the Indian Air Force. The following leave is applicable for Agniveeswari during their engagement period:-

(a) Annual Leave: 30 days per year.

(b) Sick Leave: Based on medical advice by competent Medical Authority.

17. Medical and CSD Facilities: For duration of their engagement period in the Indian Air Force, Agniveeswari will be entitled for medical facility at Service Hospital as well as CSD provisions.

18. Pay Allowances and Allied Benefits: Agniveeswari enrolled under this Scheme will be paid an Agniveeswari package of Rs. 30,000/- per month with a fixed yearly increment. In addition, Ration, Risk and Hazard Allowances (as applicable in IAF), Dress and Travel allowances will be paid. Rank such as senior, clothing - accommodation and Leave Travel Concession (LTC) will also be provided as per the existing rules.

19. Terminal Benefits - Seva Nidhi Package: AGNIYEEVAYU will be given one time 'Seva Nidhi' package comprising their monthly contribution along with matching contribution by the Government on completion of their engagement period, as indicated below:-

Note - 1: AGNIYEEVAYU will not be required to contribute to any Provident Fund in Indian Air Force.

Note - 2: There shall be no entitlement to gratuity and any kind of pensionary benefits.

20. Insurance, Death and Disability Compensation: AGNIYEEVAYU will be provided non-contributory Life Insurance cover of Rs. 48 Lakhs for the duration of their engagement period as AGNIYEEVAYU in the Indian Air Force. AGNIYEEVAYU will not be governed by provisions contained in the Person Regulations/Rules for Indian Air Force. 21. Agniveeswari Skill Certificate: At the end of engagement period, a detailed Skill Set certificate will be provided to the AGNIYEEVAYU, highlighting the skills and level of competency acquired by the personnel during their engagement period.

22. Not Entitled to the ESM Status: Agniveeswari enrolled under this Scheme will not be eligible for Ex-Servicemen status after their discharge from the Service on completion of four years engagement period.

23. Agniveeswari will not be permitted to appear in any examination for commissioning in Army/Navy/IAF during the engagement period of four years unless he/she has applied for said exam before getting enrolled.

24. Release at own request prior to completion of engagement period will not be permissible for Agniveeswari. However, in exceptional cases, personnel enrolled as Agniveeswari may be released, with approval of the Competent Authority.

## SEQUENCE OF EXAMINATION

MOBILE PHONES / SMART WATCHES / ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE PROHIBITED IN TESTING AREAS DURING PHASE-I AND PHASE-II. CANDIDATES FOUND IN DISOBEDIENCE OF MOBILE PHONES / ELECTRONIC DEVICES SHALL BE DISQUALIFIED PERMANENTLY.

Phase-I

25. Online Test: Eligible candidates will be sent admit cards for Phase-I of testing on their registered e-mail IDs between 48-72 hrs prior to the examination. Candidates are required to download the admit card, take a colour printout and carry the same to the examination centre. Name of city & exam date will be intimated to the candidates at an earlier date to enable them to plan their movement. This provisional admit card can also be downloaded by the candidate under candidates login on CASS web portal [www.cass.gov.in](http://www.cass.gov.in). All candidates in possession of provisional admit card will undertake Online Test at centres designated & allotted as per their admit card. Online test will be objective type and questions will be bilingual (English & Hindi) except for English paper. Candidates are to bring one blue/black pen and original AADHAAR card along with them for Phase-I testing. Details of the test are as follows:-

(a) Science Subjects: Total duration of the online test shall be 60 minutes and shall comprise of Physics, Mathematics and English as per 10+2 CBSE syllabus.

(b) Other than Science Subjects: Total duration of the online test shall be 65 minutes and shall comprise of English as per 10+2 CBSE syllabus and Reasoning & General Awareness (RAGA).

(c) Science Subjects & Other than Science Subjects: Total duration of the online test shall be 65 minutes and shall comprise of Physics, Mathematics and English as per 10+2 CBSE syllabus and Reasoning & General Awareness (RAGA).

(d) Marking pattern for online test:-

- (i) One mark for every correct answer
- (ii) Nil (0) marks for unattempted question
- (iii) 0.25 marks shall be deducted for each wrong answer.

**BEWARE, IMPERSONATORS WILL BE PROSECUTED**

26. Above examination methodology has been designed to facilitate selection process based on qualifications of candidates irrespective of the examination methodology adopted. Candidates are liable to be assigned by duty in organisational hierarchy at the discretion of the Indian Air Force.

27. Marks scored by the candidates in STAR Phase-I Testing will be "Normalised" by using the formula as published on the web site to take into account variance in difficulty levels of the question papers across different sessions. Candidates are to note that the application of Cut-off for shortlisting of candidates for STAR Phase-II testing and preparation of Final Merit List for selection will be based on Normalised Marks\* and not on the Actual Marks scored by the candidate in STAR Phase-I testing. Further, on normalisation, marks of a candidate in a subject may become less/more than his marks and more/below marks of that subject in other subjects in exceptional cases.

**CANDIDATES ARE SO QUALIFIED IN EACH PAPER INDIVIDUALLY IN SCIENCE SUBJECTS AND OTHER THAN SCIENCE SUBJECTS, WITH NORMALISED MARKS.** The result of Phase-I and shortlisting for Phase-II based on their performance in three online test will be uploaded in candidates individual log-in ID on:

#### PHASE-II

28. Soon after the declaration of the result of Phase-I (Online) Test and SHORTLISTED candidates will be applied on the normalised marks scored by the candidates in the Phase-I Test and SHORTLISTED candidates will be sent a New admit card on their registered e-mail ID for Phase-II test at the designated ASC. The admit card for Phase-II exam can also be downloaded online under candidate's login on CASB web portal.

- (a) Colour printout of Phase-II Admit card.
- (b) Colour printout of duly filled Application form.
- (c) HB pencil, eraser, sharpener, glue stick, sharpener and double end ball point pen for writing.
- (d) Eight copies of an attested passport size colour photograph (which was used for the online application registration).
- (e) Father's name and mother's date of birth.
- (f) Original and four self-attested photocopies of matriculation marks sheet (only applicable for three years' Diploma / two years Vocational Course holders when English is not a subject in Diploma / Vocational Course).
- (g) Original and four self-attested photocopies of Intermediate (10+2) equivalent examination passing certificate and marks sheet.

#### OR

- Original and four self-attested photocopies of two years' vocational course passing certificate and all marks sheets including non vocational course with subjects English, Maths and Mathematics.

- (h) Certificate for COAFC (Central Ordnance Accounts & Finance), including certificate for children of serving/retired/deceased Air Force civilian employees paid out of retirement annuities which can be downloaded at the case may be from the download section of CASB web portal and brought along while reporting for Phase-II of the examination.
- (i) Original Phase-I admit card during Phase-I test bearing Air Force seal and signature of authority.

- (j) Original and four self-attested photocopies of A, B or C certificate (if applicable).

Note: Original NCC certificate must have serial No., round seal of issuing authority and stamp of signing authority. Photo affixed on the certificate must have been issued by issuing authority with stamp.

Note: Candidates discharged from the IAF for any reason are not eligible to appear in the selection test.

29. Additional Skill Qualifications/Achievements: Candidates with any additional skills / qualifications / achievements in fields, including but not limited to Information Technology, Motor vehicle driving / Maintenance, Hospitality, Logistics, Accounting, Catering, Welding, Typing Skills, Sports etc, are required to upload supporting certificates/documents through a link provided along with Phase-II call letter and also furnish them at the time of Phase-II testing.

30. Verification of Eligibility: Candidates should be in possession of the documents mentioned at para 28 & 29 above, when appearing for the selection test which would be scrutinised prior to commencement of Phase-II to ascertain the eligibility prima facie. Detailed verification of all the documents listed at para 28 & 29 above shall be carried out in respect of candidates who pass Physical Fitness Test. Candidates of those who do not meet the laid down educational criteria shall be cancelled during initial verification of original certificates & mark sheets and also during detailed verification at ASC.

Note-1: In the case of COAFC, the name of the candidate, parents' name and the date of birth of the candidate as mentioned in the discharge book / service book / service particular certificate / casually certificate (as applicable) must be the same as mentioned in the matriculation passing certificate of the candidate.

Note-2: Under no circumstances the candidates shall be permitted to appear in Phase-II of the selection test without original educational marks sheet/cassing certificates & documents mentioned above in paragraph 28. However, candidates with photocopies of educational marks sheets/cassing certificates may be permitted to appear in the selection test only on production of a certificate from their school/college principal certifying that original certificatesheets are deposited with college/school. In exceptional circumstances, documents verified certificates will be accepted and candidates will be issued with CGV (Candidate Status) Verification status. Candidates are then later required to submit original certificates to nearest ASC within one month from date of issue of CGV to clear the CGV status.

Note-3: The original passing certificates/mark sheets shall not be retained by the selection centre. The same shall be returned to the candidates on completion of detailed verification.

Note-4: Internet copy of mark sheet not acceptable.

Note-5: Candidates are strictly prohibited from doing any rough work or write anything anywhere on the Admit Cards issued for Phase-I and Phase-II. Such candidates will be DEBARRED PERMANENTLY.

31. Physical Fitness Test (PFT): Names of the shortlisted candidates, who qualify the online test, shall be displayed on the CASB Web Portal and an updated list shall be called at designated ASC for Physical Fitness Test (PFT) and Adaptability Test (AT). PFT consists of two parts, PFT-I and PFT-II.

PFT-I: Candidates have to complete 1.6 Km run as per the following timings to qualify for PFT-II:

PFT-II: Candidates who qualify PFT-I & undergo PFT-II after 10 minutes of recuperation time. The sequence of exercises and maximum time period for male and female candidates are as follows:

10 Push-ups	01 minute	Test will be conducted after 10 minutes break on completion of run.

#### FEMALE CANDIDATE

Test	Max Time Period	Remarks
10 Sit-ups	01 minute and 30 seconds	Test will be conducted after 10 minutes break on completion of run.
15 Squats	01 minute	Test will be conducted after 02 minutes break on completion of 10 Sit-ups

Note: Candidates are advised to bring the sports shoes and short track pants. Detailed procedure on expected technique for Push-ups, Sit-ups and Squats is available on CASB Web Portal.

32. Candidates shall sign to consent for undergoing a physical fitness test/medical test for selection in IAF. He / She shall appear in these tests at his / her own risk and shall not be held responsible by IAF for injury/cause if any sustained by him / her during such tests. The consent form shall be signed by parents/guardians of candidates below 18 years of age. The consent form is appended with Phase-II Admit card.

33. Adaptability Test-II: All candidates who pass Physical Fitness Test will have to undertake Adaptability Test-II as per policy in vogue. Adaptability Test-II is for selection of candidates who can adjust to the environment of the Indian Air Force and are able to adjust to the military way of life.

#### Phase-II

34. Medical Examination: Pre-dates and finally Adaptability Test-II shall be linked with medical appointment letter at respective ASCs. Medical examination shall be conducted by Air Force Medical Team as per IAF medical standards and policy in vogue on subject. Issue Medical examination shall be conducted by Air Force Medical Team as per IAF medical standards and policy in vogue on subject. Issue Medical examination would also include the following Baseline Investigations:-

- (a) Blood Haemoglobin -Hb TLC B.C.
- (b) Urine R.E.M.
- (c) Biochemistry
- (d) Blood Sugar Fasting & PP
- (e) Serum Cholesterol
- (f) Urea, Uric Acid, Creatinine
- (g) LFT-Serum Bilirubin SGOT SGPT
- (h) X-Ray chest (PA view)
- (i) Ultrasonography of lower abdomen & Pelvis (For female candidates only)
- (j) ECG (R)
- (k) Any other test necessary in the opinion of the Medical Officer.

Candidates declared medically unfit can avail the option for Appeal Medical Board (AMB) against their unfitness by depositing Rs. 40/- in a Government Treasury/RBI/through Electronic Money Reconcileable Order (MRO)/Military Receivable Order (MRO). The application for AMB along with original copy of e-MRO/MRO, photostyle of Unfitness Certificate are to be submitted to the representative of ASC within three working days of medical examination.

35. The recruitment medical officer and the specialist doctors of Armed Forces are the final authorities on declaring a candidate fit or unfit during initial medical examination, appeal medical board and medical examination prior to enrolment. The candidates shall be governed by Armed Forces standards which may be at variance from civil standards. There is no provision for re-examination or review after the appeal medical board.

Note-1: Candidates are advised to get teeth and stains removed from their teeth before appearing for the Medical Examination. Ears should be free of wax. Candidates should be prepared to stay for the medical examination for four to five days under their own arrangement. No TADA shall be admissible.

Note-2: Passing in the medical examination is not a guarantee for employment in the Indian Air Force.

Note-3: Request for change of Medical Examination Centre or Date of Medical Examination shall not be entertained.

(d) Passport size recent colour photograph taken not before December 2023, of size 10 KB to 50 KB (front portrait in light background without tag/rack and head gear except for SADF); the photograph is to be taken with candidate facing a black slate in front of his/her chest with neither name and date of photograph taken clearly written on it with white chalk in capital letters. Change in appearance (by growing beard, head gear etc.) in comparison to the photograph may result in cancellation of candidature for STAR online examination and Phase-II.

- (e) Candidate's left hand thumb impression image (Size 10 KB to 50 KB).
- (f) Candidate's signature image (Size 10 KB to 50 KB).
