


Map-1: Siraj Mondal Road




Map-2: Saha Pukur Road

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Map-3: Halishar Panbasti




Map-4: Kalyani B14

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

Conclusion:

The Students analysed the data for patterns and relationships between the indicators of healthcare spending that include *aggregate healthcare spending in an economy, including expenditure relating to hospitals, home health agencies, prescribed drugs, nursing facilities, personal healthcare* and economic performance. The overall results strongly suggested a positive correlation between

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healthcare expenditure and the economic indicators of income, health check-up. While healthcare expenditure is negatively associated with multi-factor productivity, it is positively associated with the indicators of labour productivity and personal spending. This survey based awareness campaign explores the association of public health expenditure with economic performance across the States.

The investigation saw that in our locality many people had a problem with hospital facilities. Many people had faced problems after COVID-19, they lost their job. Healthcare expenditure places households under considerable financial strain in the selected areas.

Overall, the survey was a resounding success. Students became aware about some these social issues. They got the practical knowledge about the social scenario. It will hopefully foster well-rounded, socially responsible, and engaged individuals. The programme was succeeded with their report writing and formal presentation.

of urban water crises and governance mechanisms in India with a case study of Shimla. Soma has a Master's degree in Geography with the University Gold Medal for Academic Excellence from Sikkim University, and an M. Phil. in Development Studies from TISS, Mumbai, where she explored the spatialities of water in a caste society like India. Soma has presented her research at many international conferences and has also been engaged in a number of research projects on WASH, Forest Resource Rights and Governance Mapping and Green Economy. Her broad research interests include environmental governance and policy, political ecologies of water, climate change, gender & urban studies.





Presentation by the Speaker

Ms. Soma Sarkar spoke on the topic of urban water crisis from a multi-disciplinary perspective referring to both theoretical approaches and her own extensive and intensive fieldwork-based evidence (see the above photo). Water and urban environments co-evolve continuously through intricate interrelationships that are temporally contingent, and spatially variable, moving across non-linear progressions. This leads to unceasingly embryonic urban and resource configurations. Over the years, many cities across the world have experienced major water shortages with differential impacts on the different sections of society. This lecture was designed to create an understanding of the contested nature of waterscapes in a city. It drew upon Elinor Ostrom's Bundle of Rights to explain case studies from Purulia and Shimla and urged for a multi-method and multi-stakeholders' inquiry to understand water contestations.

In her presentation, Ms. Sarkar elucidated the multifaceted nature of the urban water crisis, addressing its socio-economic, environmental, and governance aspects. Drawing from her research findings, she underscored the unequal distribution of water resources within urban landscapes, exacerbating disparities and vulnerabilities among different socio-economic groups.

Ms. Sarkar also shed light on the role of governance structures, policy frameworks, and community participation in mitigating the urban water crisis. Her interdisciplinary approach provided valuable insights into the complexities of water management, emphasizing the need for holistic strategies and collaborative efforts.

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Following the presentation, an interactive session ensued, allowing participants to engage with Ms. Sarkar and exchange perspectives on potential solutions to the urban water crisis. The session facilitated meaningful discussions and knowledge sharing among attendees, fostering a deeper understanding of the challenges and opportunities in water resource management.

Overall, the One Day National Level Awareness Programme "Urban Water Crisis: An Interdisciplinary Inquiry" was a resounding success, thanks to the insightful presentation by Ms. Soma Sarkar and the active participation of attendees. The seminar served as a platform for academic exchange, critical reflection, and collaborative action towards addressing one of the most pressing challenges of our time – the urban water crisis.

The participants, especially the students, were extremely excited as they could learn something very new both topically and methodologically through a fruitful and engaging question & answer session where students and faculties actively participated. All in all the day was a great success and has certainly made a difference to the way we view our environment.






**Joint Webinar in Association with Aligarh Muslim University,
